Definitions:

- Contingent debt:** These typically are guarantees of other obligations or warranties issued by the debtor. Nothing is owed now, but something might happen in the future that could result in an obligation.
- Unliquidated debt:** These are claims such as loss of enjoyment of life, pain and suffering, etc. which are not subject to certain calculation.
- Priority Debts:** The following debts: Domestic Support, Wages, salaries and commissions, contributions to employee benefit plans, deposits owed to individuals, taxes, claims for death of injury while the debtor was under the influence.
